Professional Fee\$350
Professional consultation with licensed personnel, which may include, but is not limited to, professional
advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to planning cremation.
Documentation and Registration\$275
Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested,
including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's cremation certificate, documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country. As part of this service, we will provide you with up to 12 Proof of Death certificates which are acceptable for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.
Proof of Death Certificates, up to 12
Additional Proof of Death Certificates are available for \$7.00 each beyond the initial 12 provided.
Transfer from Place of Death\$215
Transportation of the remains from place of death to our holding room during normal operating hours of 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. For transfers beyond a 50 km radius, an additional fee of \$2.05/km will apply, round trip, for extra mileage. If transporting after our operating hours of 9:00 am to 5:00 pm., there will be an additional fee of \$200.00.
Basic Preparation of Remains\$175
The preparation of the body for placement into the cremation casket/container, includes bathing, dressing, and the setting of facial features for identification without embalming.
Comfort RoomIncluded
Identification is to take place by the immediate family before cremation or burial. This period shall be limited to the executor, spouse, or children only, will not exceed 20 minutes.

When human remains are to be cremated, a refundable deposit of \$350 will be required to be paid. If the cremated mains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.
